## Principal's Message

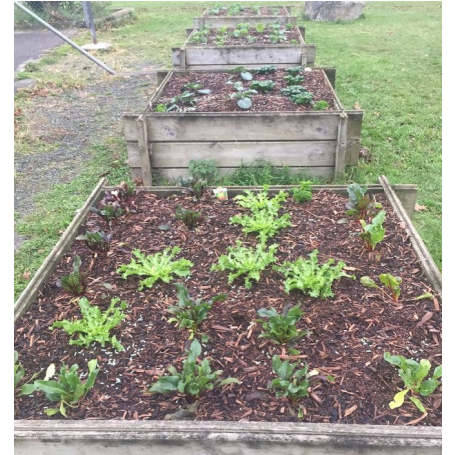
