ORINI ATHLETIC CLUB

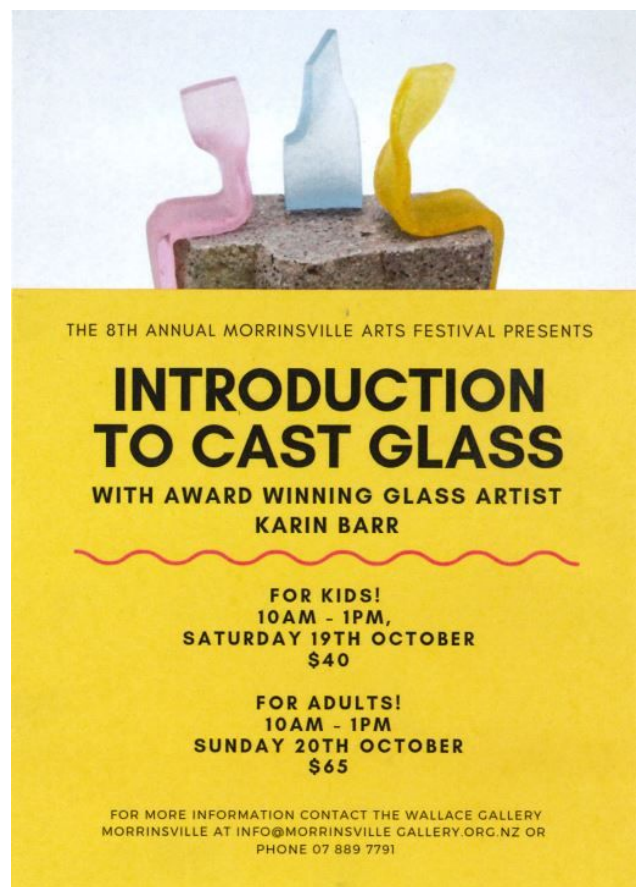
