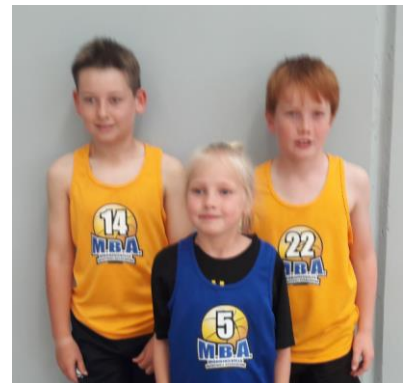
Prizing giving starts at 4 pm. This year prize giving will include an individual and team challenge with an award for each of the winners as well as a prize for the best team member.

## TRY THESE QUICK FRUIT MUFFINS

- 1 c flour
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 1 c oats
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 1/3 c sugar
- 1/4 c oil
- 1 egg – beaten
- 3/4 c low fat milk
- 1 c diced fruit

- Sift flour and baking powder, add other dry ingredients
- Mix fruit with egg, milk and oil. Add to dry ingredients
- Mix until just combined
- Spoon into muffin trays
- Bake at 180°C for 15 – 20 mins
