Very special thanks to the PTA who will cover the cost of the Life Education Visit. All families who have paid will be refunded. (attached to this newsletter)

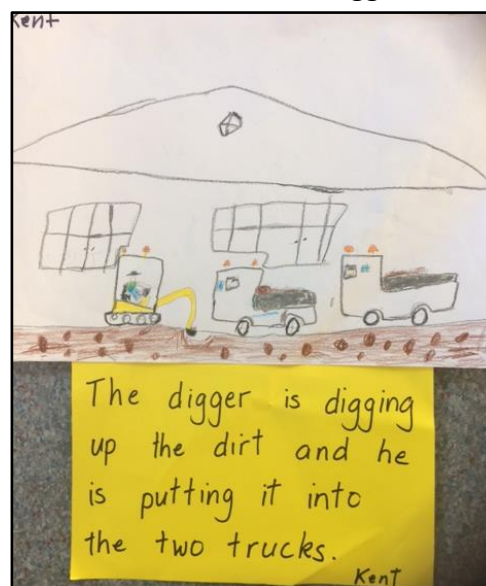
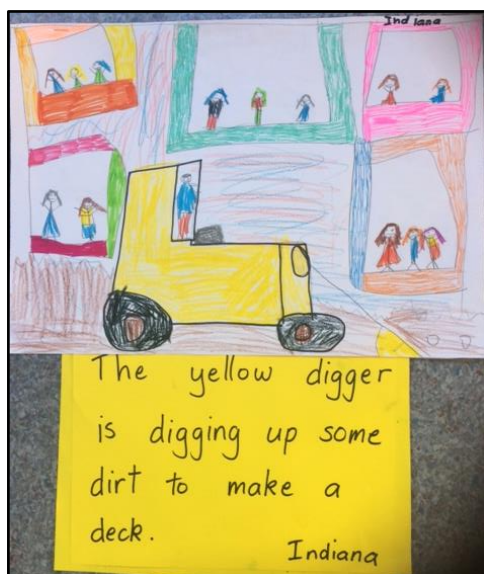


Project Update

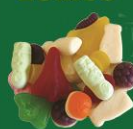
