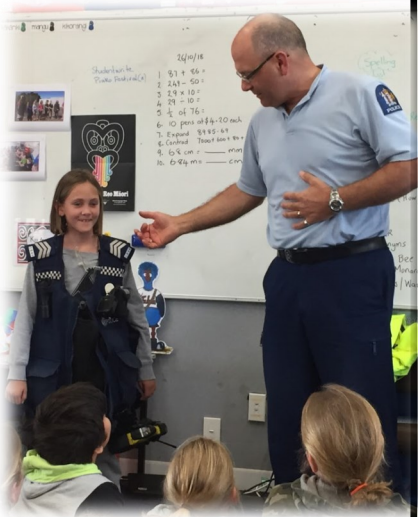

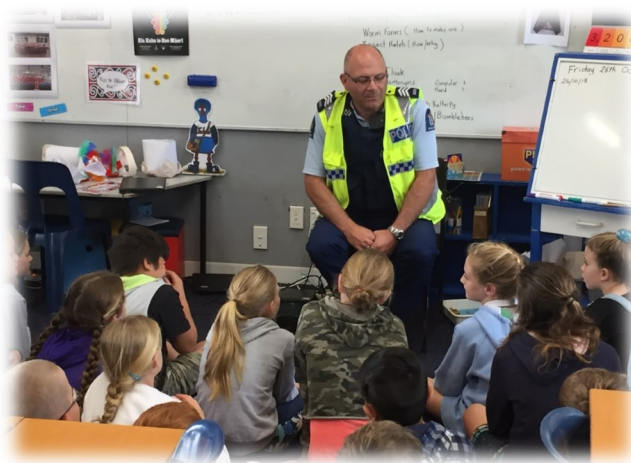


After School Bus Procedure

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After School Pick Up Procedure

Purpose: A safety procedure to ensure all students safety after school when traveling home from school.

All students who are travelling on the school bus immediately after school will assemble in zone 1, and their names will be read out from the school bus roll.

All students in the bus immediately after school must have on their bus vest before they leave the school

All students are to stay in school grounds until your ride arrives (Bus, car or other transport).

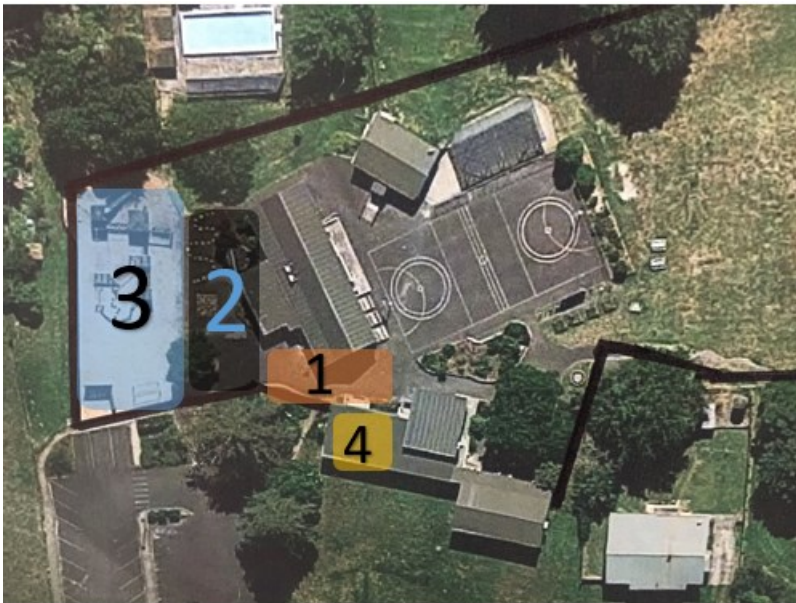
All students are to stay within the designated play zones.

Zone 1: In front of the staffroom

Zone 2: Concrete beside classrooms

Zone 3: Playground area

Zone 4: Staffroom (weather back up)



Students are to wait for the bus to stop moving before they leave through the gate.

Students who are not leaving by bus are to tell a teacher* they are leaving and who is picking them up.

In the event only one child remains to be picked up, they will wait at zone 1.

In the event of conditions that remove zones 1-3 from use, students will be seated in the staffroom seating areas.

*Teacher – an adult that is affiliated with the school
